Spanish III lessons are designed to strengthen the Spanish abilities of students who are intermediate proficient in Spanish in order to reach an advance level of proficiency in writing, reading and speaking Spanish. These lessons encourage students to participate actively and complete their daily class work, which includes oral, listening, and written assignments.

Textbook: Aventura 3

Each week students will receive three grades composed of Daily participation, homework, and a test. For each day that a student does not participate or does not turn in class work or homework, one letter grade will be deducted from his or her weekly participation or homework grade. These components will be equally weighed for quarter reports.

**Daily participation and class work-** Daily participation and class work will be graded weekly. However, for each day that a student does not participate or does not turn in class work, one letter grade will be deducted from his or her weekly participation grade. Class disruption or behavior issues will also negatively affect the participation grade.

**Homework-** Homework will be given during class and can be done as class work. However, if a student does not finish an assignment in class, he or she will be responsible for completing the assignment at home and turn it in, before the beginning of the next class.

**Test-** Each chapter will have a test. Tests may include an oral, listening, and written assignment. Each week students will be tested on what they have been working during the week.
